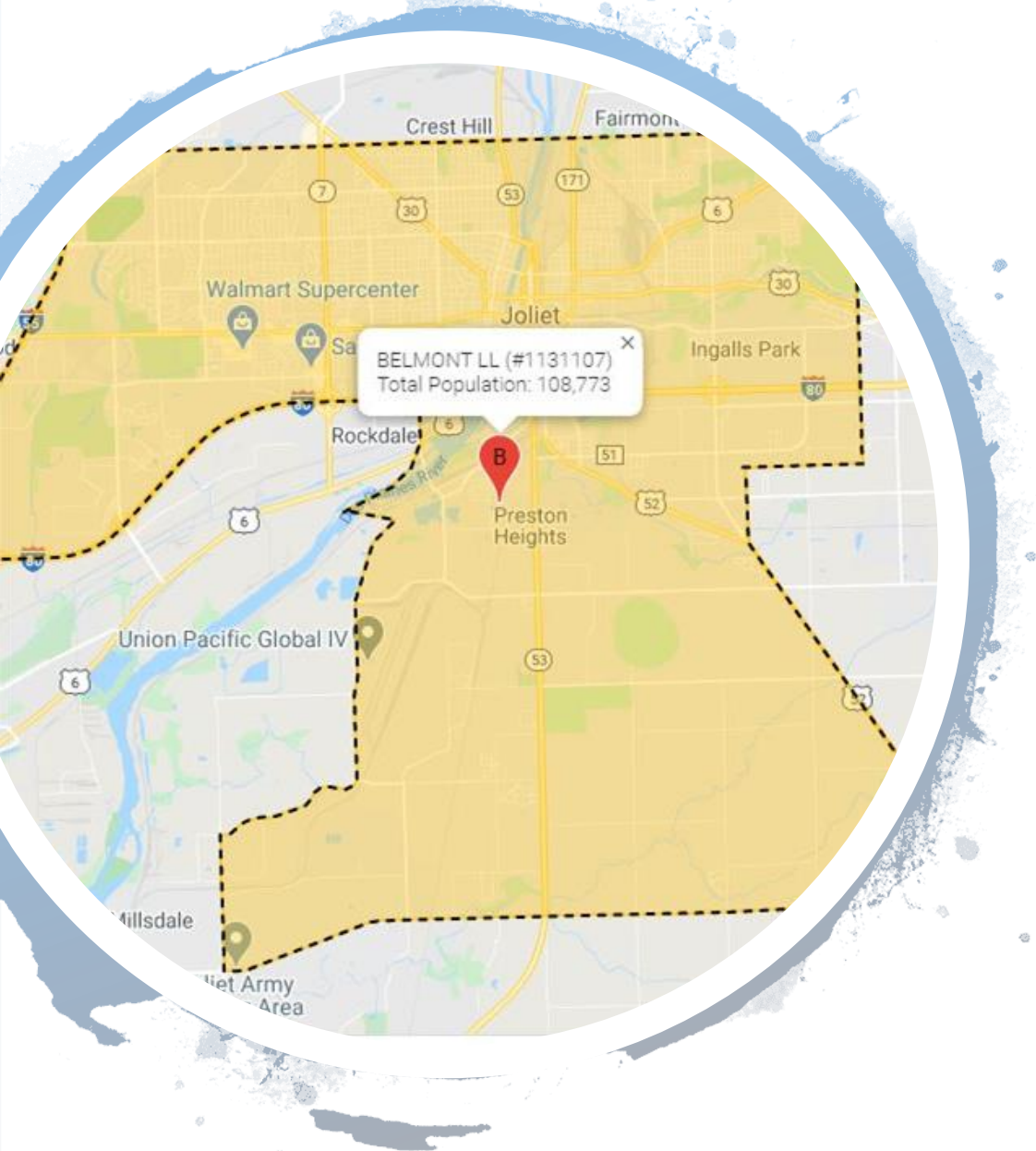

League Boundary



- You must live within the boundary or go to school in Joliet School District in order to register. The league can take players who live “outside of district” but a waiver must be signed by the League President and Local District Administrators
- II(a) and II(d) Waivers
 - This rule allows a player who has previously qualified under residency for a league and played in the league to remain in the league after having the moved to a new residence or school.
- IV(h) Waivers
 - If a person has previously resided within the league’s boundaries for two or more years while serving that league as a dedicated manager, coach, or member of the local league’s Board of Directors for two or more years, his sons and/or daughters are eligible to try out and be selected by teams in that league provided such service to the league from which the person has moved has continued and subject to written agreement from the league within whose boundaries they currently reside.

Post-Season Play for Little League Baseball & Softball

For players that want that get picked for post season tournament teams, see the outline below. These tournaments will take place sometime in late June, July and August depending on how far our teams advance.

Office Little League International Tournament Teams

- 10s District team (Ages 8-10) District and State Tournament
- 11s District Team (Ages 9-11) District and State Tournament
- 12s District Team (Ages 10-12) District, State, Regional and World Series
- Juniors District Team (Ages 13-14) District, State, Regional and World Series
- Seniors Team (Ages 15-16) District, State, Regional and World Series

To be eligible for tournament team

- You must play at least 60% of regular season games to be eligible
- You must live within or go to school within our district or have a waiver on file (prior to the tournament)
- Supply 3 forms of residency to prove that you live in district
- School Waiver forms are due by March 13th
- Spring Registration fees have been paid in full

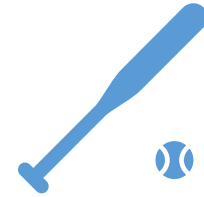

USA Bat Rule for Little League Baseball Only

- As of January 1, 2018, the new USA Baseball Bat Standard was implemented. USABat Standards bats must be used in the Little League Major Division and below. Either USABat Standard or BBCOR bats must be used for Junior League Baseball Divisions. At the Senior Division, all bats must meet the BBCOR standard.
